

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work sample - townhomes



This duplex townhome is the first built project designed by Pristereo. Designed across two subdivisions where a single family home previously lived, the site is located within both an urban transit corridor and suburban setting.

The project design needed to balance the needs for increased density while also sitting well within the neighborhood context. The large three bedroom 2,000 sf units were articulated into separate masses to create the illusion of a series of smaller spaces and avoid a singular heavy mass. Landscaping and stepped pathways were influenced by a nearby neighborhood creekside walking path.

Pristereo produced a series of digital renderings in-house to readily convey to the client proposed concepts for both the building exterior and interior spaces. These renderings evolved over time, and the final iterations are shown here.

Pristereo's services for this project included Schematic Design, Design Development, Planning Department submittal and approved design, structural coordination, and working drawing pricing package.






Project Concept Illustration




Two units extruded on the site



Town planning require setbacks




Required spaces broken down into separate masses




Abstracted conceptualization technique used to create the building forms.

Pristereo has produced logo and mark design for a range of small business clients. Clean forms, clarity of color, and legible typefaces are employed to evoke simple brand statements. These designs have been used to help clients create website headers, business cards, and tshirt designs.

Pristereo takes a simplistic, modernist approach to graphic design, which is selfevident in the work to the right. A logo should legibly say what a business does while also targeting potential customers with an evocative aesthetic. Redundant imagery and text should be removed and refined down to the simplest mark or logo possible.

Pristereo created all of the logos and marks shown to the right in vector format, and provided layouts for a variety of uses cases. Pristereo has also worked directly with printers and fabricators to deliver finished products to clients.
